21-23 June, 2024

Rules and Regulations

ENTRIES

- 1. Entries close: April 30, 2024.
- 2. Unless otherwise stated, the Great Southern Con-Petition (GSC) is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category of performing arts for which he/she wishes to enter. Conservatorium teachers are not eligible to enter.
- GSC is for current students of Hume Conservatorium, Mitchell Conservatorium, Orange Regional Conservatorium, Riverina Conservatorium and Young Regional Conservatorium.

- 5. No late entries. For assistance in entering please contact the office info@youngrc.nsw.edu.au
- 6. It is the responsibility of the entrants, teacher, parent or carer to list the correct section numbers on entry. GSC accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries received.
- 7. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by GSC.
- 8. Unless otherwise stated, any item may only be performed in one section and an entrant may only enter once in each section.
- 9. GSC reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
- 10. Competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Conpetition start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator.
- 11. The age of the competitors will be as at June 21, 2024.
- 12. Only one piece is to be played or one movement of a sonata, unless specified, with the exception of Grade and Diploma sections when a collection of shorter pieces from examination syllabus may apply.
- 13. Competitors cannot play in more than one grade section and no more than one championship.
- 14. If entering a grade section, competitors must not have sat for a higher grade examination than the section entered. Grade section pieces must be from any recognised examination Syllabus and the copy provided to the adjudicator must state Grade and which Examining Board the piece is from.
- 15. Time limits must be observed. These are the maximum an item may be shorter than the limit but not exceed it. Should time limits be exceeded, the competitor will be disqualified.



PERFORMANCE

- Teachers may accompany children aged 8 or under, or children playing from tutor books, onto the stage, to ensure they are correctly positioned, set up and comfortable to perform. The teacher must leave the stage during the performance.
- 2. Competitors must be present at the beginning of the session as withdrawals may alter the order of appearance.
- 3. There will be no rehearsals allowed on stage.
- 4. Presentation should be appropriate to stage appearance. Dress code is smart casual at the least. Care should be taken with language and gesture.
- 5. Works performed should be suitable for a family audience. Works deemed unsuitable may be disqualified.
- 6. All pieces written with an accompaniment must be accompanied. Competitors must provided their own accompanist or recording. If recordings are used, the competitor must supply and manage their own equipment.

ADJUDICATOR

- 1. The adjudicator's decision is final.
- 2. Prompting or coaching, except by the adjudicator, is not permitted.
- 3. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
- 4. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received with a \$40 fee. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and their eligibility to appear in any age grouping, or their eligibility to perform in a graded section, GSC will consult the CEO of the appropriate conservatorium.
- 5. A copy of music must be provided for the adjudicator. Photocopies provided will be destroyed by GSC.

PRIZES

- 1. Prizes may include cash; trophies; certificates
- 2. For sections with;
 - a) three (3) or fewer competitors, only 1st prize shall be awarded;
 - b) for five (5) competitors, only two prizes;
 - c). for up to eight (8) competitors, will all three prizes be awarded.
 - d) If more than 12 competitors in a section, a 4th place may be awarded.



PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING

1. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage areas, and in silent mode in all other areas at all venues. Private recording is permitted only by the parent/representative or teacher of a competitor on stage. No photography during a performance.

GENERAL

- 1. Supervision All school aged attendees are to be supervised by parents at all times.
- 2. All competitors compete AT THEIR OWN RISK. GSC takes no responsibility for any accident or personal loss or injury, however caused. This includes any loss, theft or damage to any personal property.
- 3. There will be no additions to the program unless the omission is the fault of GSC.
- 4. GSC has the right to amend the program at any time.
- 5. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate, the Con-petition office MUST be notified.
- Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of GSC on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final.
